Why is Amending the Redevelopment Plan a Political Process?

- The pre-recession vision of the CRA may not be the same as the post-recession vision of the CRA (e.g., North Miami CRA/Biscayne Landings project and one for one affordable housing requirement)
- Additional publicly funded capital projects
- New indebtedness of the CRA
- Extending the life of the CRA
 - 30 years after the FY in which the plan is adopted
 - If CRA created after July 1, 2002, 40 years after the FY in which the plan is adopted
- Expanding the boundaries of the Community Redevelopment Area



Why is Amending the Redevelopment Plan a Political Process?

- Legal Requirements
 - CRA Board Approval
 - Municipal Approval
 - County Approval



- Grassroots Participants
 - Community Leaders
 - Homeowner's/Condominium Associations
 - Neighborhood Associations
 - Downtown Business Associations
 - Chamber of Commerce



- CRA Participants
 - CRA Advisory Board
 - CRA Board



- Municipal Government Participants
 - City Council/Commission
 - (typically the same as the CRA Board)



- County Government Participants
 - County Mayor
 - County Commissioners
